5. Special Instructions: (Be Brief)

Schedule: All Scheduled, Unscheduled & Ad Hoc Welfare Nets will start on the EARS W4HHH Repeater. Should the repeater go down or the Gilmer County EM need this repeater, follow protocol and page 1 channel usage. In addition, Welfare Communications will be attempted at 30 minutes after the hour starting at 11:00 AM Local time beginning with Channel 12 then following the schedule as noted in the Remarks column on Page 2. Once contact is made stay there and ignore unless or until comms are lost. Then start with the next hour. Report any significant Traffic to Gilmer EC as appropriate.

CAUTION: While Channels 11 through 18 fall within Amateur Bands, Channels 12->17 will Require an Amateur License Class of General or higher to Tx - Technician Class Operators please refer to Channels 1 ->10 Page 1. The Assignment Priority shall be Ellijay Amateur Radio Society [EARS] with Gilmer EM Welfare traffic handled as needed.
